

Divine Guidance – 3 “Multiple Witnesses”

Romans 8:14-16 (KJV)

John 16:13 (KJV)

[Inner Witness]

1. The voice of God
2. Visions and dreams (prophecy)
Acts 2:17-18 (KJV)

Example: Acts 9:10-12 (KJV) (Paul & Ananias)

3. Promptings of the Spirit
Feelings / grieved / pressed / stirred
Example 1 – Paul (told “no”)
Acts 16:6-10 (KJV)

Example 2: Acts 16:18 (Paul) “.... being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her.”

Example 3: Acts 17:16 (Paul) “.... his spirit was stirred in him.”
Amplified: “ ... his spirit was grieved and roused to anger.”

Example 4: Acts 18:5 (Paul) “.... was pressed in the spirit and testified to the Jews that Jesus was Christ.”

[How To Test / Discern the Spirit ?]

“It’s okay to judge to know if this is God or just me.”

I John 4:1 (KJV) “Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God...”

I Thessalonians 5:21 “Prove all things; hold fast to that which is good.”

I Corinthians 14:29 “Let the prophets speak, two or three, and let the others judge.”
(NLT) Evaluate what is said

[Principle of Multiple Witnesses]
(Divine Guidance Systems)

Deuteronomy 17:6 (KJV)

Deuteronomy 19:15 (KJV)

Matthew 18:16 (KJV)

II Corinthians 13:1 (KJV)

I Timothy 5:19 (KJV)

John 5:30-39 (KJV)

(Jesus called God her Father – vs. 16-29)

1st witness = Jesus Himself (“If only witness don’t believe me!”)

2nd witness = John the Baptist

3rd witness = Works of Jesus

4th witness = Heavenly Father

5th witness = Scriptures (66 books; approximately 40 authors)

NOTE: If Jesus needed multiple witnesses, it’s okay for me to seek and expect multiple witnesses.
