Healing II "Paul and Others"

[Paul]	
Galatians 4:13-16 ((KJV)

1. Whatever it was, he got over it (at the first)

2. Galatia (Antioch; Iconium; Lystra; Derbe) Paul's first missionary journey

Acts 14:19-22 (KJV)

- 1. Jews from Antioch and Iconium stoned him and left him for dead (Acts 23:12-13 More than 40 Jews bound themselves together with a curse, saying we will not eat or drink till this man be killed.)
- 2. Disciples prayed over him.
 God raised him up.

3. The next day, he walked from Lystra to Derbe (approximately 20 miles) and preached the Gospel.

Puffy eyes? Yea, and a body, too!!

[Timothy]

I Timothy 5:21-25 (KJV)

- 1. Drink no more water (that was a command)
- 2. We assume water is good everywhere not so!!
- 3. The water was making him sick.

He had an alternative.

Mark 16:17-18 drink any deadly thing and it will not harm them

- This is divine protection, not a license to tempt God.
- " Take up serpents.... "

[Trophimus]

II Timothy 4:19-20 (KJV)

- 1. Trophimus Paul left at Miletus sick
 Paul left people lost, as well, and God still willed to save them.
 He left people broken-hearted
- 2. Preachers are not immune to sickness.

3. This proves Paul did not have special powers to heal and you getter get it before he dies.

Ex. Acts 14:15 We are also men of like passions with you

Ex. Acts 3:12 (Peter) why look ye so earnestly on us, as though by our own power or holiness we ha made this man to walk....

[Epaphroditus]

Philippians 2:24-30 (KJV)

- 1. He was a fellow minister with Paul.
- 2. He over-worked himself.
- 3. Again, we see that Paul did not have any special power.

[Elisha]

II Kings 13:14-21 (KJV)

- 1. Elisha got sick and died.
- 2. You can be anointed and still have a personal battle (sin or sickness)
- 3. This sickness did not cancel out his anointing.
 - * He was still used by God.
 - * After his death, his bones raised a man from the dead.
- 4. God's word is still truth, regardless of mine or anyone else's experience.
 - * No condemnation only compassion
